Reading

At Inmans we encourage children to read at least four times a week. This is the main focus of homework and benefits children in so many ways. Older children can complete their own reading record, but younger children may need some help. Even 5 minutes a day can support fluency so please support your child by listening to them read.

Parking, Staff Car Park & Pedestrian Entrance

We would like to remind parents/carers to please park considerately around the school. Please do not park and block any driveways, do not park blocking the entrance/exit of the staff car park, do not park on the bend near kids club or on the zig zag lines. Please do not use the staff car park at start/end of the day unless you have authorisation first. We have school transport and parents of our enhanced provision who need to use these spaces to safely get their children in and out of school and to their car. Please do not use the staff car park entrance as a pedestrian entrance, this causes significant safety issues. Please use the designated pedestrian entrance.

Absence from school

If your child is ill and will be off school then please call the school office on 01482 899485, the voicemail is the first option and the line opens at 8am. Please clearly state your child's full name, class and give as much detail as possible to why they're off ill eg-sickness bug/chicken pox/cough etc.

Medication

If prescribed medicine is needed 4 times a day we can administer this once during the school day for you. We can only administer items that have been prescribed by a doctor/dentist and have a pharmacy label on with their name and instructions. Parents/carers must fill in a medicine consent form.

Helping Hands Community Shop & Library

Our community shop and library are open to members of the local community and the parent/carers of pupils at Inmans Primary School. The shop/library are situated in the main entrance of the school and is open term time Monday-Friday 8-5pm. Anyone can use these facilities regardless of income.
